

SPONSORSHIP GUIDELINES

During the 2018/2019 school year, Rideshare's Safe Routes to School program is offering schools in San Luis Obispo County sponsorship funds to support school-site Safe Routes to School (SRTS) programs. Examples of school-site SRTS initiatives include:

- Organization and promotion of Walk/Bike to School Days
- Implementation of a School Pool program (carpool matching via iRideshare.org software)
- Formation of a Bike Brigade and/or Walking School Bus
- Creation of and/or support for a school-site Transportation Safety Team
- Promotion of a Mileage Incentive Program using irideshare.org
- New program ideas are always welcome!

The mission of Rideshare's SRTS program is to educate and empower school communities, K – 12 students, and parents through tools and incentives that encourage active transportation choices and create change in family/student commuter habits. The San Luis Obispo County SRTS program also acts as a clearinghouse for school site safety data and infrastructure inventories throughout the region.

Any San Luis Obispo County school faculty member, administrator, or parent wishing to build or grow a Safe Routes to School program is welcome to apply for sponsorship funds. Selected applicants will receive support in the form of reimbursable sponsorship dollars, community resources, giveaways, and Rideshare staff support. Additionally, Rideshare will market your school as a Safe Routes to School community member in public relations activities, advertisements, newsletters, and on our website.

Three (3) Funding Levels Available:

GOLD: \$601 to \$800

• Monthly student events throughout the entire school year (for at least eight months) including participation in both International Walk to School Day on October 10, 2018 and National Bike to School Day on May 8, 2019

SILVER: \$401 to \$600

• Four events throughout the school year including participation in both International Walk to School Day on October 10, 2018 and National Bike to School Day on May 8, 2019

BRONZE: Up to \$400

• Participation in both International Walk to School Day on October 10, 2018 and National Bike to School Day on May 8, 2019

Eligibility

- School site must be within San Luis Obispo County
- School serving K 12th grade
- Adult-supervised elementary, middle, or high school groups or clubs
- Community-based or private non-profit organizations engaged in improving child safety and promoting active transportation for children through walking and biking to school
- Support from the participating school's principal*

*Attach a letter of support from the school principal to your application and submit these items to Rideshare no later than Friday, September 28, 2018.

All Applicants Must Demonstrate:

- Project falls under the mission of the San Luis Obispo County Safe Routes to School program
- Project involves two or more of the following groups: students, parents, community, or school staff/faculty
- Project is approved by the school principal; a letter of support must be included with the application
- Reimbursable program costs equate to no more than \$800
- Ability to provide Rideshare Program Coordinator/Public Information Officer with status reports on program

Awards will be given to programs showing a high potential for longevity and sustainability.

Ineligible Expenses Include:

- Staff salaries
- Infrastructure projects (construction or demolition)
- Fundraising
- Cash, Gift Cards, Gift Certificates (unless donated)
- Electronic Equipment
- Bikes for raffles, incentives, prizes, or giveaways (unless donated)
- Skateboards, Scooters
- Incentives used for non-SRTS events
- Incentives intended to reward event attendance rather than participation in the program
- Event participant meals (healthy snacks are eligible)

Reporting Requirements:

Upon the project's completion, Rideshare requires that sponsorship recipients provide the following information by <u>May 31, 2019</u>:

- Budget Worksheet of actual expenditures (attached) with copies of receipts (attached)
- Activity/Event Record worksheet (attached)

Reimbursement will occur once per school year. Rideshare will distribute reimbursement checks before June 30, 2019.

- Use SRTS logos provided by Rideshare.
- Send all marketing materials and press releases used for promotion to SLOCOG's Public Information Officer (<u>adevers@slocog.org</u>) for approval.
