# 5 Steps to Get Started in a Vanpool



#### **Find Your Vanmates**

Identify 5 or more people that have a similar schedule and commute as you. These may be coworkers or people working at a location close to you. Once you have your group, designate a vanpool captain.

## **Explore Your Options**

Decide which vanpool provider you would like to use. We currently contract with three vanpool providers to cover up to 50% of your monthly vanpool costs. Contact vendors about lease pricing and vehicle options.

<u>Commute With Enterprise</u>, or <u>VTS</u>.



Once you have identified your preferred vanpool provider, please email **info@rideshare.org** to start the application for the monthly subsidy.





## Fill Out The Rider Agreements

The vanpool captain will then need to complete the <u>Vanpool Application</u> and each rider will need to complete a <u>Rider Agreement Form</u>. Rideshare will review your documents and let you know when your vanpool is approved.

### **Get On The Road!**

Once you are approved, your vanpool can get on the road! Vanpools must complete a monthly ridership log (provided by Rideshare staff) and submit it to **info@rideshare.org** before the 3rd of every month. Failure to do so can impact subsidy eligibility.
