



A vanpool is like a carpool except it holds more people! Typically it's a group of 5-15 people who commute to and from work together in a van or SUV. The van itself is leased and paid for by the riders, with the primary driver being the leaseholder.

## Where does the van pick up?

Vanpoolers usually meet at a central location that suits everyone. Some vanpools have multiple pick ups but others have only one. It's totally dependent on what's best for the group and what they collectively decide.

#### What is the commitment?

It's a month to month commitment!



### How much does it cost?

Typically vanpools cost between \$90-\$120/month per person plus gas, but SLOCOG can cover up to 50% of this cost with our subsidy. Pricinging includes a complete service package, vehicle registration, insurance and maintenance.

### How many people do I need?

You need 5-15 people to start a vanpool!

#### Who drives?

In some vanpools, everyone takes turns driving; in others, passengers cover the full commute costs of the driver. Drivers of vehicles with 11 to 15 passengers must get a DMV medical. The cost in 2021 for this certification is \$140.

# What's the deal with the subsidy?

SLOCOG provides up to a 50% subsidy per month for vanpools that have a minimum of 50% average occupancy. Vanpools are required to keep a daily log of vanpool riders (provide by Rideshare) to receive the monthly subsidy.
